Section 1: Instructions to Offerors

1. **Introduction:** The Famine Early Warning Systems Network (FEWS NET) 7 Pillar 1 Project is a USAID program implemented by Chemonics International in Afghanistan. The goal of the FEWS NET 7 Pillar 1 project is to provide timely, accurate, evidence-based, and transparent food security early warning information and analysis. As part of project activities, the FEWS NET 7 Pillar 1 project requires the purchase of transportation services to provide a dedicated vehicle and driver for the project's daily use and provide an additional vehicle and driver on an ad-hoc basis to conduct provincial travel. The purpose of this RFQ is to solicit quotations for these services.

Offerors are responsible for ensuring that their offers are received by Chemonics in accordance with the instructions, terms, and conditions described in this RFQ. Failure to adhere with instructions described in this RFQ may lead to disqualification of an offer from consideration.

2. **Offer Deadline and Protocol:** Offers must be received no later than 04:30 PM local Kabul time on October 2, 2023 by email or by hard copy delivery to the FEWS NET 7 Pillar 1 Afghanistan office. Any emailed offers must be emailed to mojamal@chemonics.com. Any hard copy deliveries must be stamped and signed by the offeror's authorized representative and delivered to the FEWS NET 7 Pillar 1 project office located at Mohib Towers, First Floor, Bibi Mahro, Airport Road, Kabul, Afghanistan.

Please reference the RFQ number in any response to this RFQ. Offers received after the specified time and date will be considered late and will be considered only at the discretion of Chemonics.

3. **Questions:** Questions regarding the technical or administrative requirements of this RFQ may be submitted no later than 04:30 PM Kabul time on September 28, 2023 by email to mojamal@chemonics.com. Questions must be submitted in writing; phone calls will not be accepted. Questions and requests for clarification—and the responses thereto—that Chemonics believes may be of interest to other offerors will be circulated to all RFQ recipients who have indicated an interest in bidding.

Only the written answers issued by Chemonics will be considered official and carry weight in the RFQ process and subsequent evaluation. Any verbal information received from employees of Chemonics or any other entity should not be considered as an official response to any questions regarding this RFQ.

4. **Scope of Work:** Section 3 contains the Scope of Work for the required services.
5. **Quotations:** Quotations in response to this RFQ must be priced on a fixed-price, all-inclusive basis. Prices must be presented in local currency (AFN). Prices must be inclusive of all Taxes and costs (including worker's compensation insurance mandated by U.S. Defense Base Act (DBA insurance)). Offers must remain valid for not less than sixty (60) calendar days after the offer deadline. Offerors are requested to provide quotations on their official quotation format or letterhead; in the event this is not possible, offerors may complete the table in Section 3.

In addition, offerors responding to this RFQ are requested to submit the following:

- Organizations responding to this RFQ are requested to submit a copy of their official registration or business license;
- Individuals responding to this RFQ are requested to submit a copy of their identification card;
- Company profile or 2-3 pages introduction to company's areas of expertise and practice, and description of the team and main clients;
- A minimum of three (3) references (with name and contact information) indicating the relevant services carried out in the last three (3) years that best illustrate

organization/individual's qualifications and past performance. References from USAID or similar donor-funded projects are preferred. Independent verification of the references may be carried out. Chemonics reserves the right to obtain past performance information from sources other than those identified by the offeror;

- Narrative description of past performance for similar services;
- The CVs of all proposed drivers with references of previous experience driving a vehicle under transportation services agreement (TSA);
- Copy of NID and driving license of all proposed drivers; and
- List of all available vehicles (type, make & model)

The price quotation be submitted separately from above documents. All other parts of this quotation must not make reference to pricing data in order that the technical evaluation may be made strictly on the basis of technical merit.

6. **Delivery:** As part of its response to this RFQ, each offeror is expected to provide an estimate (in calendar days) of the delivery timeframe (after receipt of order). The delivery estimate presented in an offer in response to this RFQ must be upheld in the performance of any resulting contract

7. **Source and Authorized Geographic Code:**

a) All services offered in response to this RFQ or supplied under any resulting award must meet **USAID Geographic Code 937** in accordance with the United States Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), [22 CFR §228](#). The cooperating country for this RFQ is the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan.

Offerors may not offer or supply services or any commodities that are manufactured or assembled in, shipped from, transported through, or otherwise involving any of the following countries: Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Syria.

Any and all items that are made by Huawei Technology Company, ZTE Corporation, Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, Dahua Technology Company will not be accepted. If quotes include items from these entities, please note that they will be deemed not technically responsive and excluded from competition.

b) The USG has implemented a blanket prohibition on providing direct government financing to international solar projects that source from suppliers that are the subject of a [withhold release order](#) (Hoshine Silicon Industry), on the Commerce Entity List, or otherwise sanctioned for their use of forced labor. The PRC energy companies that were added to the Commerce Entity List for their ties to forced labor are found below.

NOTE: Offerors may not purchase from any of the Suppliers listed below without advance written approval from Chemonics/USAID.

- Hoshine Silicon Industry (metallurgical grade silicon and silicon products) - also subject to a WRO
- Xinjiang Daqo New Energy (polysilicon, wafers)
- Xinjiang East Hope Nonferrous Metals (polysilicon, ingots, wafers)
- Xinjiang GCL-New Energy Material (polysilicon, ingots, wafers, cells, modules)
- Xinjiang Production and Construction Corps (state-owned paramilitary organization, electricity supplier)

This does not mean that all PRC-produced solar panels are immediately blocked. Currently, the restriction is just on any panels or products that are directly purchased using USG funds

from any of those above companies. Should the purchase of any solar panels or components be required, Chemonics/USAID prior review and written approval is required.

c) **Taxes and VAT:**

The agreement under which this procurement is financed is not exempt from the payment of taxes, VAT, tariffs, duties, or other levies imposed by any laws in effect in the Cooperating Country. Therefore, offerors must include taxes, VAT, charges, tariffs, duties and levies in accordance with the laws of the Cooperating Country.

d) **UEI Number:** Companies or organizations, whether for-profit or non-profit, shall be requested to provide a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) number if selected to receive an award in response to this RFQ valued greater than or equal to USD\$30,000 (or equivalent in other currency). If the Offeror does not have a UEI number and is unable to obtain one before the submission deadline, Offeror shall include a statement noting their intention to obtain a UEI number should it be selected as the successful offeror or explaining why registration for a UEI number is not possible. Contact sam.gov to obtain a number. Further guidance on obtaining a UEI number is available from Chemonics upon request.

e) **Eligibility:** By submitting an offer in response to this RFQ, the offeror certifies that it and its principal officers are not debarred, suspended, or otherwise considered ineligible for an award by the U.S. Government. Chemonics will not award a contract to any firm that is debarred, suspended, or considered to be ineligible by the U.S. Government.

f) **Evaluation and Basis for Award:** The award will be made to a responsible offeror whose offer follows the RFQ instructions, meets the eligibility requirements, and meets or exceeds the minimum required technical specifications and is judged to be the best value based on a lowest-price, technically-acceptable basis.

Please note that if there are significant deficiencies regarding responsiveness to the requirements of this RFQ, an offer may be deemed “non-responsive” and thereby disqualified from consideration. Chemonics reserves the right to waive immaterial deficiencies at its discretion. Best-offer quotations are requested. It is anticipated that award will be made solely on the basis of these original quotations. However, Chemonics reserves the right to conduct any of the following:

- Chemonics may conduct negotiations with and/or request clarifications from any offeror prior to award.
- While preference will be given to offerors who can address the full technical requirements of this RFQ, Chemonics may issue a partial award or split the award among various Vendors, if in the best interest of the FEWS NET 7 Pillar 1 project.
- Chemonics may cancel this RFQ at any time.
- Chemonics may reject any and all offers, if such action is considered to be in the best interest of Chemonics.

Please note that in submitting a response to this RFQ, the offeror understands that USAID is not a party to this solicitation and the offeror agrees that any protest hereunder must be presented—in writing with full explanations—to the FEWS NET 7 Pillar 1 project for consideration, as USAID will not consider protests regarding procurements carried out by implementing partners. Chemonics, at its sole discretion, will make a final decision on the protest for this procurement.

g) **Terms and Conditions:** This is a Request for Quotations only. Issuance of this RFQ does not in any way obligate Chemonics, the FEWS NET 7 Pillar 1 project, or USAID to make an award or pay for costs incurred by potential offerors in the preparation and submission of an offer.

This solicitation is subject to Chemonics' standard terms and conditions. Any resultant award will be governed by these terms and conditions; a copy of the full terms and conditions is available upon request. Please note the following terms and conditions will apply:

- (a) Chemonics' standard payment terms are net 30 days after receipt and acceptance of any commodities or deliverables. Payment will only be issued to the entity submitting the offer in response to this RFQ and identified in the resulting award; payment will not be issued to a third party.
- (b) Any award resulting from this RFQ will be firm fixed price, in the form of a TSA.
- (c) No services or commodities may be supplied that are manufactured or assembled in, shipped from, transported through, or otherwise involving any of the following countries: Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Syria.
- (d) Any international air or ocean transportation or shipping carried out under any award resulting from this RFQ must take place on U.S.-flag carriers/vessels.
- (e) United States law prohibits transactions with, and the provision of resources and support to, individuals and organizations associated with terrorism. The Vendor under any award resulting from this RFQ must ensure compliance with these laws.

h) DEFENSE BASE ACT (DBA) INSURANCE

- a) FAR 52.228-3 WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE (DEFENSE BASE ACT INSURANCE) (Jul 2014) [Updated by AAPD 22-01- 6-10-22]

The Subcontractor shall (a) provide, before commencing performance under this Subcontract, such workers' compensation or security as the Defense Base Act (DBA) (42 U.S.C. 1651, et seq.) requires and (b) continue to maintain it until performance is completed. The Subcontractor shall insert, in all lower-tier subcontracts authorized by Chemonics under this Subcontract to which the Defense Base Act applies, a clause similar to this clause imposing upon those lower-tier subcontractors this requirement to comply with the Defense Base Act. DBA insurance provides critical protection and limits on liability. The Subcontractor shall provide a proof of DBA insurance coverage to Chemonics upon request. Chemonics will verify coverage for, at least, projects in high-risk environments and where Chemonics may be providing security.

- (b) AIDAR 752.228-3 WORKERS' COMPENSATION (DEFENSE BASE ACT) [Updated by AAPD 22-01- 6-10-22] As prescribed in AIDAR 728.308, the following supplemental coverage is to be added to the clause specified in FAR 52.228-3.

(1) The Subcontractor agrees to procure DBA insurance pursuant to the terms of the contract between USAID and USAID's DBA insurance carrier unless the Subcontractor has a DBA self-insurance program approved by the U.S. Department of Labor or has an approved retrospective rating agreement for DBA.

(2) If USAID or Subcontractor has secured a waiver of DBA coverage (See AIDAR 728.305-70(a)) for Subcontractor's employees who are not citizens of residents of, or hired in the United States, the Subcontractor agrees to provide such employees with worker's compensation benefits as required by the laws of the country in which the employees are working, or by the laws of the employee's native country, whichever offers greater benefits.

(3) The Subcontractor further agrees to insert in all lower-tier subcontracts hereunder to which the DBA is applicable a clause similar to this clause, including the sentence, imposing on all lower-tier subcontractors authorized by Chemonics a like requirement to provide overseas workmen's compensation insurance coverage and obtain DBA coverage under the USAID requirements contract.

For instructions on the required application form and submission requirements, please refer to [AAPD 22-01](#). Pursuant to AIDAR 752.228-70, medical evacuation is a separate insurance requirement for overseas performance of USAID funded subcontracts; the Defense Base Act insurance does not provide coverage for medical evacuation. The costs of DBA insurance are allowable and reimbursable as a direct cost to this Subcontract.

Before starting work, the offeror must provide Chemonics with a copy of the DBA coverage policy that covers each of its employees.

Section 2: Offer Checklist

Section 3: Scope of Work and Technical Qualifications

The purpose of this RFQ is to engage the firm to provide transportation services (consisting of a vehicle and driver) to Chemonics and FEWS NET 7 Pillar 1 project. The firm shall, and when requested, provide the following services:

1. A dedicated vehicle (Toyota 4runner 4x4 model 2018 or higher, color white, or silver) with driver for Kabul field office to meet the project's daily transportation needs.
2. A dedicated vehicle (Toyota Hilux 4X4 model 2016 or higher, color white or silver) with driver to facilitate transportation to Afghanistan provinces on an ad-hoc basis.

Technical Qualifications that the selected offeror must possess:

- Minimum (5) of years of experience and proven track of record providing the services outlined in Scope of Work
- Staff assigned to these tasks must have a minimum (5) years of experience and have completed all required certifications and licenses required by local law and regulations.
- Experience with USAID or other donor-funded projects in (Afghanistan), especially those implemented by for-profit international firms like Chemonics, is highly preferred.

Drivers

Subcontractor-provided drivers will meet the following minimum requirements:

- Local national driver with five (5) years of experience driving professionally, including at least three (3) years of experience driving for a reputable organization.
- Fluent in Dari and Pashto. Upon request by the project, good proficiency in any major dialect (Uzbek, Hazara, Tadjik, etc.) spoken in the areas to be specified for each purchase order.
- Capable of operating a soft-skin vehicle in urban, open-road, off-road, limited visibility, and, when necessary, inclement weather conditions in order to ensure safe personnel movement through the application of sensible driving practices.
- Fully qualified in operating the applicable vehicle and in using all required equipment, including equipment, basic first aid kit, and navigational aids.
- Proven proficiency in defensive driving tactics and techniques required, with attendance of refresher defensive driver and basic road safety training at least annually. Yearly defensive driver refresher certifications must be available to the project upon request.
- Qualified in first-line repairs and maintenance, as well as operating manual and automatic transmission vehicles.
- Shall be experienced within areas to be specified for each purchase order and will be able to use local relationships and knowledge to support the mission.
- Must be legally licensed to operate a vehicle in Afghanistan and must have held a driving license for more than five (5) years.
- A professional demeanor with good communication and interpersonal skills; good judgment and self-discipline are required.
- Must have a clean driving license for serious related offences.
- Must have a clean criminal record.

Equipment

Subcontractor-provided vehicles will have (at a minimum) the following equipment:

- Tool kit with all tools needed to change tires and make basic field repairs, including an air compressor and tire plug/patch kit at a minimum
- An emergency signaling triangle
- Towing winch and/or towing cable

- Farm jack/hi-lift jack or bottle jack
- Jumper cables
- One spare tire, serviceable and properly inflated; with the option of having a second tire made available upon request for longer trips in rural locations
- A fully stocked first aid kit capable of being used to treat moderate injuries, including cuts, scrapes, burns, bruises, and sprains
- A functioning fire extinguisher, inspected by the subcontractor every 6 months
- The option for at least one 20L jerrycan of spare fuel made available upon request for longer trips in rural locations
- The option for an emergency water supply (at least 3L per person) and non-perishable food made available upon request for longer trips in rural locations
